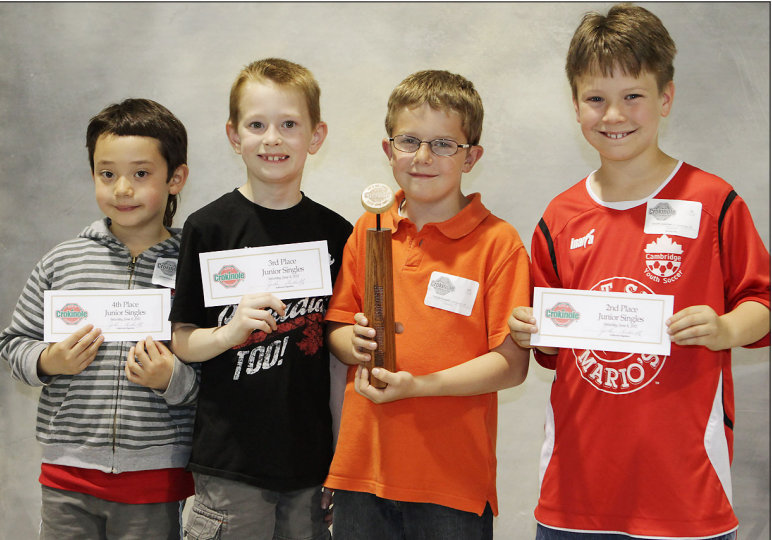

## B.C. player learned crokinole in China

For a Canadian citizen and now World Crokinole champion, it's hard to believe he was introduced to the game in China.

At 12 years of age, Julian Chalmers was introduced to the game two years ago while his family was living in China. His father, Charles, is an English teacher in the B.C. School in Dalian, China where other Canadian teachers were playing the game.

The local restaurant had a board and Julian would play there until they found someone to make a board for them, complete with jade pegs. Julian and Charles had matching shirts designed for them and the crokinole players in China.

Returning to Canada after a two-year contract, Charles purchased a Willard board so he and Julian could practice on the proper WCC surface. On March 19, 2011, Julian entered into the BC crokinole championships in Oliver, B.C. organized by local enthusiast Clif Antypowich, known in the community as Crokinole Clif.

Julian placed first in the round robin tournament of 22 players and then captured first place in the B pool and finished third overall. That's when Julian's mother, Lara, said he had to come to Tavistock. She headed a fundraising drive and raised the money for Charles and Julian to attend, then visit with relatives in Montreal.

The trip was not in vain. Julian not only captured the Intermediate title over 12 competitors his own age and younger, but finished fifth out of the 80 Adult Singles participants. He had 30 points and 45 20's in the playoff rounds. In the preliminary games he finished 12th with 56 points and 91 20's. "I like skilled based games," Julian said following the win. Comparing the competition here in the intermediate category he said the players "were a lot better" than in B.C. When asked if he would return next year, he said it would have to wait. Julian's family is headed for China and won't be back in Canada for a couple of years.
